Class Kit required. Kit includes pattern and all of the fabric needed to make 48" square quilt top and binding.

Cost: \$75 Payable to Janet Fogg on first day of class (cash or checks only)

Choose from four kits for your class project:

Autumn Climber (Orange tabby cat climbing tree branch)

Spring Climber (Gray tabby cat climbing tree branch)

Winter Explorer (Light multi colored tabby cat perched in tree branch)

Summer Explorer (Dark multi colored tabby cat perched in tree branch)

Sewing machine in good working order

Zig-zag capability is helpful but not required.

Extra sewing machine needles, standard sewing

Travel iron and ironing pad (small for personal use)

Rotary cutter with new blade and medium size cutting mat

24" cutting ruler

Small cutting ruler for easy handling and cutting of small pieces (any shape)

Small sharp pointed scissors for trimming and snipping

Sharp fine glass head pins

Thimble (any type for hand applique)

Package of applique needles Size 10 (or choose a size comfortable for threading)

All purpose thread for machine piecing: medium dark brown, gray or black

Thread for hand applique:

Suggested: Small spools 100m Gutermann Sew all Polyester

Autumn Climber: golds #865 and #875, brown #575, rust #566, greens #721 and #775, ecru #520, black #010

Spring Climber: grays #110, #111 and #115, moss #775, ecru #520, black #010

Winter Explorer: brown #595, taupes #515 and #551, grays #110, #111 and #115, black #010

Summer Explorer: grays #115 and #118, taupes #515 and #551, greens #768 and #770, black #010

Invisible thread (monofilament) should you choose machine applique

Ultra fine point Sharpie pens: Black and a few light colors

Pencil and sharpener

4-6 acid free white glue sticks

11" x17" piece of foamcore (available at art supply stores. Must have a smooth surface for drawing against it)

Box of gallon size zip lock freezer bags (For organizing the sections of your quilt)

Sketchpad 8 ½" by 11" or larger and pen (ballpoint or gel pen) black or blue for drawing machine quilting motifs

Other helpful items which are optional: a portable lamp, tweezers to help position small pieces, beveled wooden seam roller or finger pressing tool for pressing seams without an iron.
